Registration, Withdrawal & Refund Policies:

This is an intensive program comprised of four courses: ELT 5530, ELT 5531, ELT 5532, ELT 5533. To be eligible to participate and earn credit, participants must register for all four courses. Content is highly integrated across the four courses to provide a robust and cohesive program. As such, partial credit and/or partial refund will not be granted.

Withdrawals submitted online 72 hours prior to the program's first class session will receive a 100% refund of SPU tuition. After this point, no refund will be granted. All withdrawals must be submitted prior to the final class session.
