**1. Critical Reflection for Each Attended Session**

Write a typed, double spaced, 2-3 paragraph critical reflection of each workshop/seminar/keynote attended.

**Assignment Guidance:**

- A. Include the title of the session, date, time spent in the session (total hours) and presenter's full name.
- B. Describe the content of the session and how it impacted your understanding of the topics presented.

**2. Critical Synthesis of Conference Attendance**

Write a typed critical reflection paper synthesizing the information learned at the conference. If you apply for 1 credit, your paper should be 2-3 pages. If you apply for 2 credits, it should be 4-6 pages.

**Assignment Guidance**

- A. Be specific in sharing how at least three concepts/techniques introduced at the sessions supported or challenged your previous knowledge or assumptions.
- B. Raise questions that require further inquiry.
- C. Identify one or more goals that you plan to work toward in your classroom, school, or work setting.
- D. Describe how you plan to implement this goal, if possible.
