Write a typed, double spaced, 7-8 page critical reflection of combined viewed sessions, including plenary, simulative and concurrent, and describe how you plan to apply this new knowledge in the classroom.

Assignment Guidance:

- A. Include the title of the session, date viewed, and presenter's full name.
- B. Describe the content of the session and how it impacted your understanding of the topics presented.
- C. Be specific in sharing how at least three concepts/techniques introduced at the sessions supported or challenged your previous knowledge or assumptions.
- D. Raise questions that require further inquiry.
- E. Identify one or more goals that you plan to work toward in your classroom, school, or work setting.
- F. Describe how you plan to implement this goal, if possible.
